Did you know that we have a Sail class starting on January 11? Yes, with three non-member students, two from past courses. With most squadrons either cancelling inroom classes or transitioning to remote learning using Zoom, the District 16 SEOs are coordinating in sharing teaching resources and co-managing classes. In this case, the Everett squadron is running the Sail class by providing an instructor and Zoom-invitations. Skagit Bay promoted the class through its mailing list and notices in the local newspapers. We listed the course in National's HQ-800 reporting system, enrolled the students, as well as collected the fees (which we keep), and managed the textbook delivery and will administer the final exam. So, both squadrons get credit for offering a class and furthering boating education in our areas.


